Thailand is the 8<sup>th</sup> largest importer of fresh fruit in Asia and accounts for 4 per cent of import trade.

Thailand imports mostly temperate fruit that it cannot grow and supply locally.

Thailand is the 3<sup>th</sup> largest exporter of fresh fruit in Asia and accounts for 17 per cent of export trade.


Thailand exports mostly tropical fruits, dominated by durian and logan to China.





Thailand imports peaked in 2020 and has eased in last 3 years.


Imports of tropical fruits from regional suppliers supplement local production.



Australia and New Zealand are the main suppliers of southern season temperate fruit including grapes, mandarins, oranges, and pears.



Thailand exports consist of tropical fruits including durian, longans and mangosteens. China and Malaysia are the main destinations. Exports increased 7 per cent in 2023 and recovered to pre covid levels ~ 1.97 million tonnes. An increase in durian exports have offset a decrease in logan and mangosteens. Pineapple exports are increasing.


Thailand is a net exporter of fresh fruit, and exports account for just 78 per cent of 2-way trade.

Thailand has recorded strong import growth since the market liberalized in early 2000s, driven by China, Thailand changed to a regulated phytosanitary market in 2012 requiring new import conditions for all fresh produce suppliers. Trade dipped as it moved to a regulated phytosanitary market.

Political instability from 2016 – 2019 impacted on import growth.

After some recovery by 2020 the impact of Covid19 further impacted on import trade.
